**REGISTRATION FEES:** Families wishing to apply for free or reduced registration fees must provide proof of income in order for the district to determine your responsibility for fees. You may pay the amount owed on the day of registration or provide verification and the district will notify you of the cost for your student's fees.

**PROOF OF RESIDENCY** is required for ALL students. Please bring a current rental agreement, property tax bill, or current utility bill to registration.

**BIRTH CERTIFICATES:** Certified Birth Certificates are required for all pre-school, Kindergarten, and new or transfer students. Please supply Medicaid numbers if Medicaid eligible

**PHYSICALS:** Must be turned into your child's school office on or before the first day of school. This is required for Preschool, Kindergarten, and 6th grade. You must show proof of a recent physical done within one year prior to the first day of the 2018-2019 school year. Physicals are also required for new students regardless of age if coming from a school other than the State of Illinois.

**DENTAL EXAM:** Required for K, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students. The required date to have this turned in by is May 15, 2019. Information regarding dental clinics will be available at registration.

**IMMUNIZATIONS:** Must show proof of being up to date with all necessary immunizations. To include Diphtheria, Tetanus & Pertussis (DTP/DTAP) required for all grades, Polio (OPV and/or IPV) required for all grades, combined Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) 1 dose required for Pre-K and 2 doses required for Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade, Chicken Pox (Varicella) 1 dose required for all grades and 2 doses required for Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grades, Hepatitis B (HBV) required for Pre-K, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades, Hib required for Pre-K students under the age of 5 years, Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap) 1 dose required for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, & 8<sup>th</sup> grades, and Meningococcal (MCV) 1 dose required for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grades.

**VISION EXAMINATIONS:** The State of Illinois has required that all students entering Kindergarten or entering an Illinois school for the first time shall have an eye examination before October 15<sup>th</sup> of the school year.

**LEAD SCREENING:** Is a required part of the health examination for children age six years or younger prior to admission to a preschool, nursery school, kindergarten or other child care program. Streator is a high-risk zip code so one blood lead level (blood test) is required to be done ideally between 1-2 years of age.

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Streator Elementary District #44 will continue to participate in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for the 2018-2019 school year. CEP allows our district to provide healthy breakfasts and lunches each day at **no charge for ALL K-8<sup>th</sup> grade students** enrolled in our school district during the 2018-2019 school year. **Additional milks** at the K-4 building **and additional milks and ala cart items** for students attending Northlawn, will still be **available for purchase**. The student must have money posted to their account in order to purchase ala carte and/or extra milk.
