1st grade

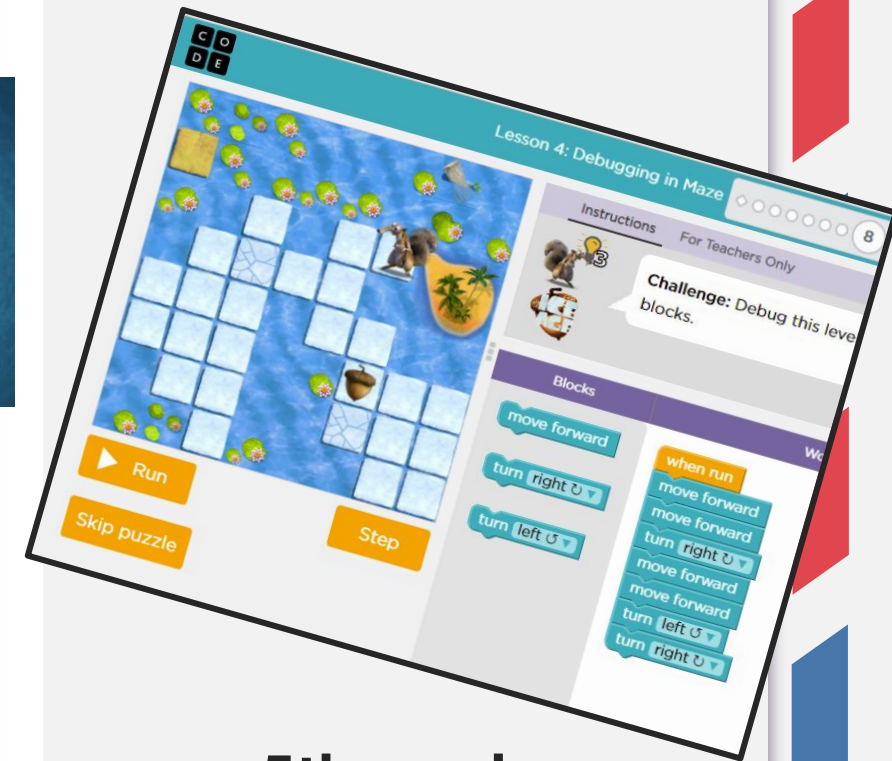
We have worked on collecting **data** and putting it into a bar graph on the computer.

We have used several picture books to learn about the importance of limiting screen time, digital citizenship, online safety, & responsible technology use.




5th grade

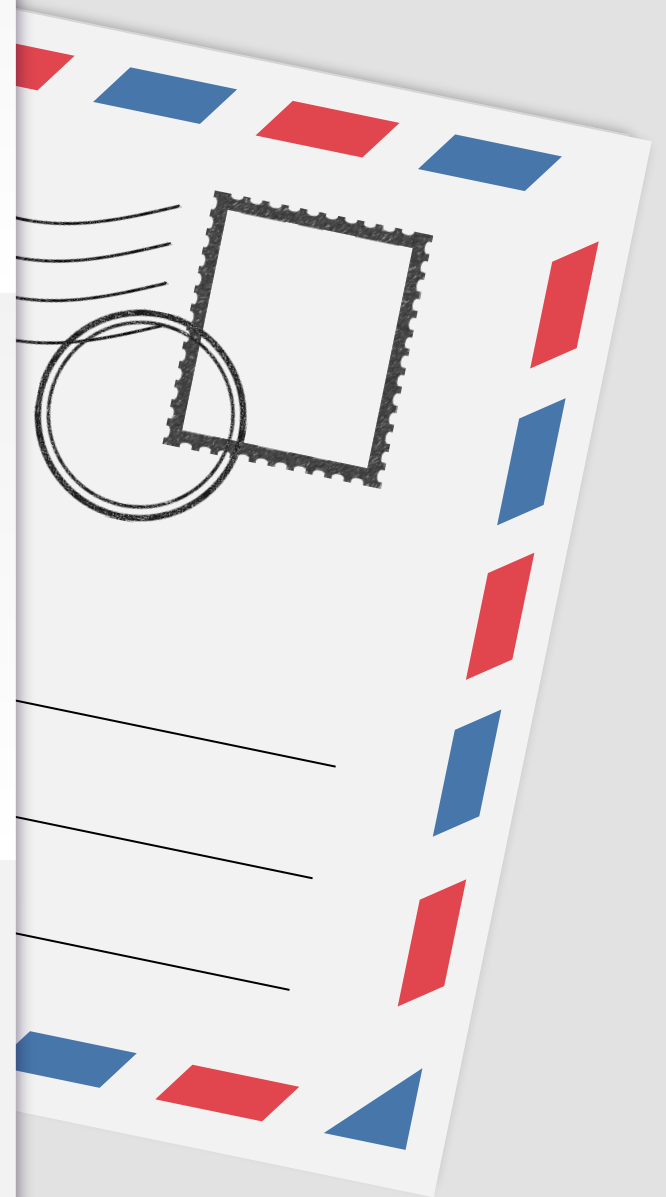
